Arms: Ermine, on a shield a chevron
or, with two cinquefoils
centered sanguine, leaved of
the second. In the base, a
martlet, on a sword barwise,
winged sable, closed, contourne.

Crest: A wolf's or bear's head, coupe,
contourne

Wreath: Or and sanguine

Nathaniel Colburn, possibly of Brentwood Parish, Essex, came in 1630 with Gov. John Winthrop's expedition to Boston. He went first to Watertown and then to Dedham where he was a landholder in 1638. He married May 25, 1639, in Dedham, Priscilla Clark(e) daughter of Rowland and Mary Clarke. They had eleven children, and continued to live in Dedham, where Nathaniel died May 14, 1691 and Priscilla Aug. 12, 1692

Ebenezer Colburn, son of Joseph and Mehitable Whiting Colburn was born in Dedham in 1738 where he married in 1763 Mercy Everett. They remained in Dedham until after the birth of their third child. They removed about 1768 to Princeton, Mass. where twin sons were born in 1769. One died age 3 days, and the surviving son given both names, Edward and Everett. Nathaniel served in a Military Company in Princeton during the Revolution under Capt. Ebenezer Jones. Five children were born in Princeton before the family moved to Natick, Mass. where they resided briefly before moving to Rindge, N.H. Three more children were born there, and Ebenezer died there. Three of the sons died in the Rindge area, where descendants still live recently.

In 1794, Edward Everett Colburn and his bride, Esther, came into Otsego County to take up land in Lispenard's and Schuyler's Patents, in what is now Plainfield. They were soon followed by Edward's younger brothers: David, and Ellis and Lewis, the twins, and Jonathan, and their wives. David and Jonathan remained only until about 1812 and then removed to Chautauqua County, in which area their descendants remain. Jonathan is said to have returned after the War of 1812 and to have died of typhoid in Plainfield. Rebecca, wife of David Colburn is buried in Burlington Flats Cemetery. Lewis removed to Sackett's Harbor, N.Y. where his descendants still lived in 1960. Both Edward and Ellis remained in Otsego County.

Edward Everett Colburn, son of Ebeneser and Mercy Everett Colburn was one of twins born March 31, 1769 in Princeton, Mass. The twins were named Edward and Everett, but when the latter died aged 3 days Edward was given his name also. He removed with the family to Natick, Mass. and then in 1779 to Rindge, N.H. He married in 1773 in Rindge Esther Lovejoy, and in 1794 removed to lands purchased in the town of Richfield, now Plainfield, in Lispenard's and Schuyler's Patents. Edward and Esther remained in Plainfield during their lives and are buried in Burlington Flats Cemetery. Their son, Dr. Leonard Colburn, built the stone house to the east of the cemetery.
